AGENDA ITEM #3: Meads Addition estimates for Elm Ave from Easy Street to the Highway Spur

Oak Creek Engineering put together a cost estimate to remove existing bit surface, build up road profile
on east half, install crushed concrete base and gravel surface roadway on west Elm Avenue in Meads
Addition. Cost estimate came out to \$60,128.45. The board discussed other options as to using white
rock as opposed to gravel. If they went this route, how long would it hold up until something more
permanent would need to be done. With other streets in town needing improvements as well with lots
that are full that have been there longer, the board felt they should be priority before Meads Addition.
