We will take refrigerators and A/C units, but the compressors must be removed. If you're not sure if an item is eligible for pick-up, call us at 856-4624 or just ask one of the guys. Please call the office to get your name on the list. If you are not on the list your items will not be picked up. Items will need to be placed on the curb where your garbage is picked up. They will begin pickup at 8:00a.m.

Daily Admission - 0-5 years will be free with adult paid admissions

6-18 years & Seniors 55+ \$3.00/Day

19 years and over \$4.00/Day

Water walking/Lap Swimming \$1.00/Day

Family Pass - \$125.00

Individual Pass - \$75.00

10 Day Punch Card - \$20.00

20 Day Punch Card - \$40.00

UNLICENSED OR INOPERABLE VEHICLES

No person in charge or control of any property within the municipality, other than municipal property, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall store, retain, or keep on, or permit to be stored, retained, or kept on a private premises any motor vehicle that has been unlicensed for a period in excess of four months under the laws of the State of Nebraska or allow any partially dismantled, inoperable, wrecked, junked, or discarded vehicle, including a motor vehicle body, motor vehicle chassis, or parts therefrom, to remain on such property longer than seven days. Provided, this section shall apply to a vehicle in an enclosed building, or an appropriate storage place or depository approved by the governing body of the village and maintained in a lawful place and manner.

SIREN REMINDERS

ONE SHORT WHISTLE: Fire Dept. Meeting (1st Thursday of every month)

TWO WHISTLES: Water shut off on south side of town for water repairs

THREE WHISTLES: Water shut off of north side of town for water repairs

SIX WHISTLES: Fire or EMS call

3 MINUTES of SOLID SIREN WHISTLE: Tornado warning, take shelter immediately

CIVIL DEFENSE TEST: 1st Thursday each month for a solid minute at 5:30pm
